Why Communist Students?

- Capitalism is in obvious decline. The need for a higher form of society based upon the principle of human need, as opposed to the needs of capital, grows ever more urgent.
- The logic of capital threatens humanity's very existence. It gives us only endless wars, ecological disaster and social disintegration.
- Capitalism cannot be reformed away. It must be overthrown through revolution the conscious act of the overwhelming majority. The struggle for democracy - both within the workers' movement and in wider society - cannot be separated from the struggle for socialism.
- Stalinism is anti-communism. We must win back the term communism to its real meaning: "the emancipation of all human beings without distinction of sex or race" (Marx). As a global system, capitalism can only be overcome globally.
- **X** There is a crisis of revolutionary leadership. Many formally anti-Stalinist organisations have drifted into Stalinism's anti-democratic norms.
- Vur movement can only advance by struggling against these practices, without getting caught up in politically rudderless activism for its own sake. Rather, the student left must unite in a single, open and democratic organisation informed by the inspiring yet practical outlook of Marxism.
